The trolley runs approximately every 30 minutes. The route stretches from Turtle Beach (south end of Siesta Key) to downtown Sarasota, with stops at key attractions.



Traveling to and from Siesta Key

- The 77 Siesta Islander travels from Turtle Beach to downtown Sarasota. It runs approximately every 30 minutes from 8am to 10pm, depending on traffic. Everyone rides free!
- Route 33 travels along Bahia Vista Street from Cattlemen Station to Siesta Beach. Service is hourly. This is a seasonal route that generally runs November through March.
- Both the 77 Siesta Islander and Route 33 stop at Siesta Key Mall, accommodating transfers to Route 14 (travels between Downtown Station and east Bee Ridge Road) and Route 17 (travels between Downtown Station and Venice Train Depot).
- \$1.50 standard fare is required at each boarding of a standard Breeze route (excludes the 77 Siesta Islander). Seniors aged 65 and over ride for \$0.75. Seniors aged 80 and over, and the first two children aged 5 and under, ride free. Additional children (aged 5 and under) ride for \$0.75.
